

Notice of Completion Fletchers Horse Farm Archimedes Screw Micro Hydro Project

GreenBug Energy Inc. is proposing to construct a 7.4 kilowatt (kW) micro hydro facility at 2173 Cockshutt Road in Norfolk County. See map. The project would consist of installing an Archimedes Screw power generating system in the remnants of an old mill beside an existing dam on the Nanticoke watercourse. It would generate approximately 55,000 kilowatt hours (kWh) of renewable energy annually.



This project is subject to the Class Environmental Assessment for Waterpower Projects and is categorized as a project associated with existing infrastructure pursuant to the Class EA. An Environmental Report (ER) has been prepared as required under the Class EA. The proposed project has been reviewed in a process

consistent with the Class EA for Waterpower Projects, the results of which are described in the Fletchers Horse Farm Archimedes Screw Micro Hydro Project ER. The conclusion of the ER indicates the project's overall effect on the environment is benign.

In compliance with the Class EA, the ER has been mailed to all parties who expressed interest for review and comment by them.

The Archimedes Screw Micro Hydro System is considered ideal for low-head dams most of which are owned by farms, municipalities, conservation authorities and First Nations. For further information concerning the Screw, contact:
